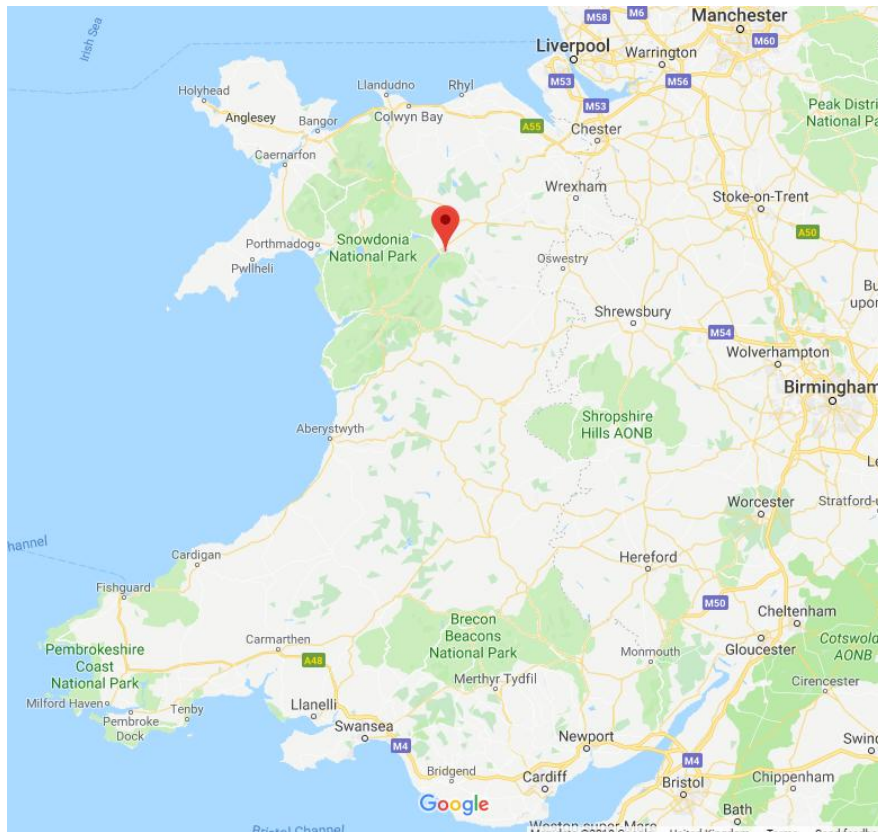

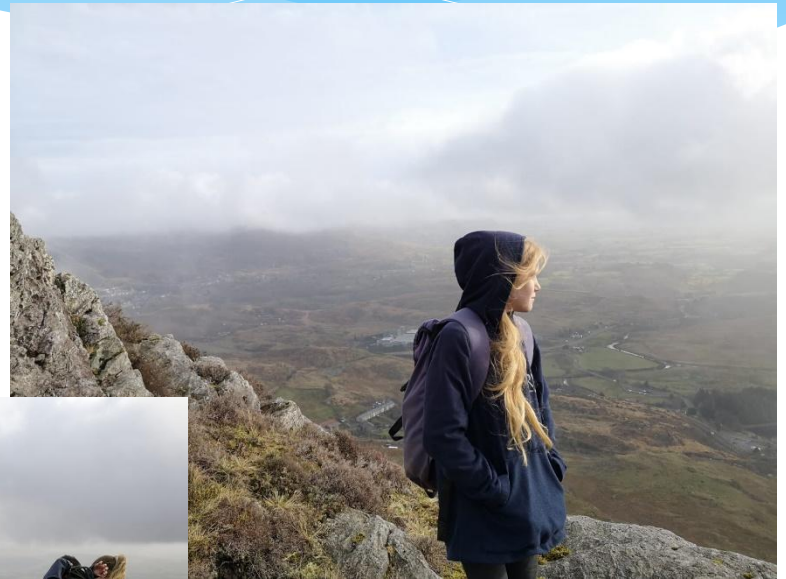
How much does it cost?

- * **FULL COST** £495
- * 6x instalments of £82.50
- * **If you are accepted for the new Targeted Funding Pupils (must have valid application prior to 31st August 2026) the cost will be halved - £247.50.**
- * 6x instalments of £41.25

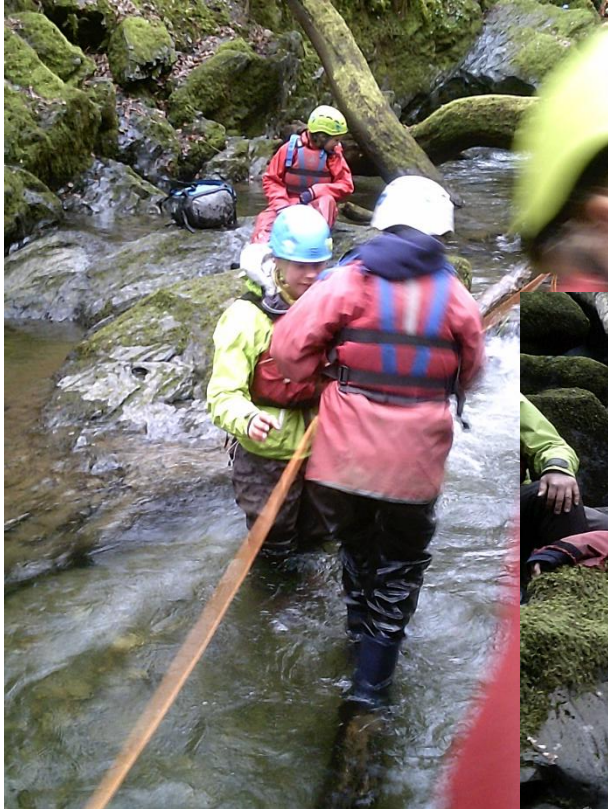
What do the children do at RYG?

Health & Safety

- * RYG is licensed by the **Adventure Activities Licensing Authority** and all instructors are highly qualified and experienced in the activities they lead.
- * We undertake a rigorous risk assessment process.
- * Children provided with appropriate safety equipment and training for all activities.
- * Instructors/school staff First Aid trained.
- * Centre staff on call in emergency during night.
- * Doctor on-call and local hospital nearby.

Accommodation



- * The main centre sleeps up to 72 children and the annexe sleeps up to 40.
- * Children stay in single sex dormitories (of various sizes).
- * Staff bedrooms are located next to the dormitories.
- * If we take more than 72, we will be the only group on site. If we have fewer than 72, another group may use the annexe (NB. The annexe is separate from the main building and has its own facilities).
- * Buildings secured by teaching staff at night.
- * Children's common room for 'down time'.

Food

- * Breakfast (juice, cereal, toast, fruit, yoghurt etc).
- * Packed lunch & drink taken to activities.
- * Three-course evening meal.
- * Hot drink and snack before bed.
- * Vegetarians and special diets catered for – **please tell us in advance**

How do we get there?



- * We travel to RYG by luxury coach.
- * The journey takes approximately 5 hours including a 60 minute lunch stop.
- * Children need to provide their own packed lunch for journey to RYG.
- * Once there, children travel by 16-seat minibuses to / from activities.

Weather



In January the average temperature ranges from -6°C / 21°F (at night) to about 7°C / 45°F (during the day).

This often means snow peaked mountains!

What to pack?

- * **All equipment needed for activities is supplied by the centre (including fleece, waterproofs, walking boots and rucksacks).**
- * Children will need a single duvet cover, pillow case, water bottle, lunch box and unbreakable (i.e. does not contain glass) flask.
- * A full list of clothes and other essentials is enclosed with the written information.
- * There is a small gift shop - £15 / £20 spending money maximum, but **not** required (Clothing will be ordered prior to trip).
- * **No mobile phones.**
- * We recommend disposable cameras only. Staff will take lots of photographs and we will upload them to a password protected section on the school website.

RYG Orientation

- * In school time.
- * Useful pre-trip preparation:
 - * Chance to ask questions
 - * Team building / Problem solving
 - * Fitness / Stamina
 - * Practice skills (e.g. climbing, map reading)

Cancellation & Refund Policy

- * For cancellations on or before **29th November 2026** (6 weeks prior to departure), you will receive a full refund of any money paid, including your deposit.
- * After that date, we regret that there will be no refund – and you may be liable for the full cost of the trip - unless there is a legitimate reason for cancellation (e.g. serious illness or injury; family bereavement) or we can find a replacement (this is because RYG will charge us).
- * If a child has to return home during the trip due to serious illness or injury, they will be due a partial refund based on the number of nights away.
