Dear parents and carers,

Children's Mobile Phones – Year 5 and 6 Only

Pupils are only allowed to bring a mobile phone into school if they are walking to and / or from school unaccompanied. **If they are being dropped off / collected then no mobile phone should be brought into school.**

To indicate you wish your child to have a phone for their safety, please sign and return the slip to the office.

The office will keep a central log so we know who should have a phone and who should not. This will also help us to make sure that the phones are looked after, as it would be very upsetting if they were lost or damaged.

Phones should be switched off completely before entering the playground and handed to the teacher as soon as they arrive. Teachers have a place where phones are kept safely.

The school reserves the right to confiscate mobile phones – or to withdraw permission - if they are used inappropriately or are not handed in (they will be returned at the end of the school day).
